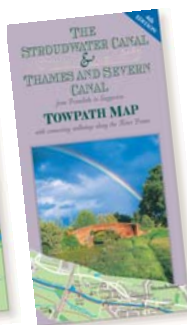

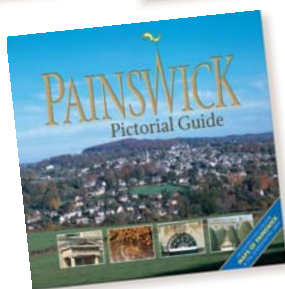

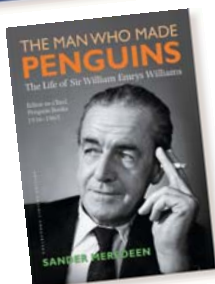


THE MAN WHO MADE PENGUINS - The Life of Sir William Emrys Williams
